Courts should grant bail if there is chance of acquittal: SC

New Delhi: Underscoring that judicial process should not become itself a punishment for the accused, Supreme Court on Friday said that courts should "take the side of liberty" and grant bail if there was a chance of the accused getting acquitted in the case.

A bench of Justices B V Nagarathna and R Mahadevan upheld a Patna High Court order granting bail to a convict sentenced to a 20-year jail term in a Pocso case for raping a tenyear-old girl. It said that the high court had rightly used its discretionary power to release the convict on bail.

Challenging the HC order, advocate Akshay Amritanshu submitted that it was a very heinous offence and HC erred. The bench, however, pointed out that the HC order had noted that the girl's age was disputed and the medical evidence did not corroborate sexual intercourse. Hinting that the HC order indicated that the convict had a good case, the bench said bail should be granted in cases when there was chance of acquittal.

Chastised, Kangana withdraws plea to bin defamation case

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Friday refused to entertain BJP MP Kangana Ranaut's plea to quash the defamation case lodged against her for a tweet related

to the 2020-21 farmers protest and asked her to fight the case in trial court. Ra-Though

naut's lawyer tried to impress upon the court that it was a simple case of a retweet that was done by many others who were not facing any prosecution, a bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta said, "It is not a simple retweet as you say. You had added something, you added spice to what was existing." SC said any observation passed by it would prejudice her case affecting the trial and asked her instead to prove her point in the trial court. The MP, thereafter, withdrew her petition.

Ranaut had moved the apex court challenging an order of Punjab and Haryana HC, which had refused to quash the complaint against her. Complainant Mahinder Kaur had alleged that the actor

had made "false imputations and remarks" against her in a retweet by saying she was the same "dadi" who was part of the Shaheen Bagh protest. Kaur was a part of protest

demonstrations against the three repealed farm laws. "There are specificallegations against the petitioner who is a celebrity, that false and defamatory imputations by her in the

retweet have dented the respondent's reputation and lowered her in her own estimation, as also in the eyes of others. Therefore, filing of the complaint to vindicate her rights cannot be termed mala fide," HC had said while dismis-

sing Ranaut's plea.

HC says Yusuf Pathan an encroacher, orders action

Ahmedabad: Gujarat high court has held cricketer and Trinamool Congress MP Yusuf Pathan

guilty of encroachment and directed Vadodara municipal corporation (VMC),

whose vacate notice he had challenged, to initiate "strict action" so that he returns a 978sq-mt plot adjacent to his house in that city.

Pathan had requested the plot from VMC in 2012 to build a stable. The civic authorities valued the land at ₹57,270 per sq-mt and passed a resolution to sell it to Pathan without an auction. The deal ran into trouble in 2014, when the then state govt rejected VMC's proposal to allot the plot to the cricketer. Pathan continued to occupy it for the next decade until a councillor flagged the discrepancy in June last year.

When VMC issued Pathan a notice to vacate the plot, he moved HC, saying he was willing to pay the market price and legally transfer it to his name.

Include sexual harassment case against you in resume: SC to VC


Says Case Time Barred, But It **Must Haunt The** Accused Forever

New Delhi: A sexual harassment complaint by a faculty member of West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences against its vice chancellor (VC) could not be looked into because it was not lodged within the mandatory threemonth period.

However, Supreme Court on Friday ensured that the "offence" did not go unpunished by directing the VC to make the judgment, which recorded his alleged acts in detail, part of his resume.

A bench of Justices Pankaj Mithal and Prasanna B Varale passed the peculiar order while dismissing the plea filed by the faculty member. The court noted that the last instance of alleged sexual harassment had taken in April

2023 but the "victim" lodged a formal complaint in Dec 2023 with the local complaint committee which rejected the complaint as 'time barred' since it was not only beyond the prescribed period of limitation of three months but also beyond the extendable period of limitation of six months.

Section 9 of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act says that any aggrieved woman may make a complaint to LCC within a period of three months from the date of incident, and in the case of series of incidents,

within a period of three months from the date of the last incident. The second proviso to Section 9 provides that the LCC may for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the time of making the complaint not exceeding three months. Noting that nothing could

be done in the case, the bench. however, ensured that the alleged wrong acts are not forgotten. "It is advisable to forgive the wrongdoer, but not to forget the wrongdoing. The wrong which has been committed against the appellant (faculty member) may not be investigated on technical grounds, but it must not be forgotten. In this view of the matter, we direct that the incidents of alleged sexual harassment on part of respondent No. 1 (VC) may be forgiven but allowed to haunt the wrongdoer forever. Thus, it is directed that this judgment shall be made part of the resume of respondent No. 1, compliance of which shall be strictly ensured by him personally," the court

The complainant had alleged that the VC repeatedly

said in its order.

used to call her in his office and proposed to her to go out for dinner. She had told him that she was not comfortable and wanted to keep the relationship professional only but he went on demanding "sexual favour from her and threatened her if the offers were declined."

"A plain reading of the entire complaint would reveal that the sexual harassment, if any, of the appellant at the hands of respondent no. 1 commenced sometime in Sept 2019, and the last incident in that connection took place in April 2023. Thereafter, no incident of sexual harassment is alleged to have taken place except for the fact that on Aug 29, 2023, the appellant was removed from the post of director, Centre of Financial, Regulatory and Governance Studies (CFRGS) or that a preliminary inquiry was instituted against her by the executive council," the court said while holding that subsequent actions of removing her as director could not be in any way linked to sexual harassment to make her plea within the time

Withdrawal of monsoon from **NW India likely** from Sept 15

New Delhi: Southwest (summer) monsoon is likely to start withdrawing from northwest India around Sept 15, two days ahead of its normal date of withdrawal, IMD said Friday.

Monsoon usually starts retreating from northwest around Sept 17 and withdraws completely by Oct 15. "Conditions are becoming favourable for withdrawal of southwest monsoon from some parts of west Rajasthan around Sept 15," Met department said.

Monsoon this year hit Kerala on May 24, the earliest onset since 2009 when it arrived on May 23, and covered the entire county by June 29.

This was also the earliest

monsoon covered the entire country since 2020 when it did so by June 26. TNN

SpiceJet flight loses a wheel while taking off, lands safely

Mumbai: A Mumbai-bound SpiceJet aircraft's tyre rolled off during take-off roll at Gujarat's Kandla on Friday. The pilots continued with the flight, and the aircraft landed safely at Mumbai airport where a 'full emergency' was declared as a precaution. No injuries were reported.

The incident occurred

around 2.40pm when the aircraft was speeding for departure from runway 23 of Kandla airport. The Bombardier DHC-8-400 has a tricycle landing gear system with a total of six wheels — two wheels on the nose gear and two main wheels on each of the main landing gear. A vid-

passenger on board, showed the outer wheel of the right hand side landing gear roll off just as the aircraft lifted off the runway. The errant tyre could be seen rolling off the runway into the unpaved portion, while the aircraft eo of the incident, taken by a climbed and the lone re-

maining tyre on the right retracted into the landing gear bay. A man could be heard saying, "Wheel nikal gaya" (Wheel came off).

"During take-off, the tower controller at Kandla air traffic control observed a black coloured big object separating from the aircraft. A jeep sent for inspection found an intact tyre and metal rings," said a source. An aircraft maintenance engineer said a wheel could come off because of a number of reasons, such as problem with the locking device, under-torqued axle nut, bearing seizure, improper wheel installation or fatigue leading to failure of retention hardware.

SpiceJet confirmed the incident.

AAP MLA sentenced to 4-year jail in Dalit woman assault case

Tarn Taran: A court in Punjab's Tarn Taran district sentenced Manjinder Singh Lalpura, AAP MLA from Khadoor Sahib, to four years in prison in a 12-year-old case of assault and molestation of a Dalit woman.

On Wednesday, the court had convicted 11 people, including six policemen, in the case. Pronouncing the sentence on Friday, additional sessions judge Prem Kumar awarded four-year jail term to Lalpura and six others, while three accused were sentenced to one-

year imprisonment each. One of the accused, Harvinder Singh, currently lodged in Delhi's Tihar Jail, did not appear in the court and his sentencing is scheduled on Sept 16. Another accused, Paramjit Singh, died during the trial.

Taliban official in India ahead of proposed foreign min trip

New Delhi: A junior Taliban minister visited India last week to participate in an exhibition on healthcare and pharmaceuticals. Deputy minister of medicine and food Hamdullah Zahid, who was in India, is equivalent to the rank of secretary in India's health ministry.

This was a rare visit by a senior Taliban official to India. It also came ahead of a likely visit by the Taliban foreign minister Amir Khan Muttagi later this year that is expected to further cement India's ties with the Taliban, even in the absence of a formal recognition by India of the regime in Kabul.

As ties continue to improve, India has remained in touch with Taliban to finalise dates for Muttagi's visit. After dates are worked out, India will seek a UNSC waiver from travel ban imposed by the council on the Taliban leader: Unlike Muttaqi, Zahid isn't on a sanctioned list and didn't require UNSC's approval to travel to India. The Taliban head of political office and Afghan ambassador to Qatar, Suhail Shaheen, told **TOI** earlier this week that there's a need for both countries to upgrade and strengthen their ties.
