

Cauvery row: Karnataka to file an appeal in SC

Siddu & Shivakumar to meet MPs, union ministers from the state to take up issue in parliament and pressure Centre

CHIEF Minister Siddaramaiah and Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar are holding a meeting with Members of Parliament (MPs) from Karnataka, including union ministers, in New Delhi on Wednesday morning to discuss the Cauvery water-sharing issue.

The CM left for New Delhi on Tuesday night. Sources said the CM and the DyCM will also hold a meeting with the state's legal team.

During the meeting with the MPs, Siddaramaiah and Shivakumar will explain to them the situation on the ground and measures taken by the state government to protect the state's interests. They will urge the MPs to take up the issue in the parliament and also put pressure on the union government to come to Karnataka's rescue, informed sources said.

The Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) has di-

rected Karnataka to release 5,000 cusecs every day for 15 days.

Shivakumar said they will also meet the union ministers. He said Karnataka is caught in a catch-22 situation after the CWMA directive. "We do not have water, but still we have to respect the authority's decision. We are appealing before the Supreme Court," he told reporters.

The DyCM said since there are no inflows, Karnataka is finding it difficult to release water, and the Centre has to help the state.

Rejecting the opposition's demand that Karnataka should continue the legal fight and not release water, Shivakumar said the state is appealing before the Supreme Court.

Meanwhile, former CM and BJP leader Basavaraj Bommai said by making repeated mistakes, the government was putting people in a quandary. He said taking an all-party delegation to Delhi to meet the PM was nothing but misleading people.

250 farmers detained for rail roko in TN

AROUND 250 farmers owing allegiance to the Tamil Nadu Cauvery Farmers Association were detained on Tuesday for staging rail roko in Thanjavur and Tiruvavur demanding the union government to ensure Karnataka released Cauvery water for TN.

In Tiruvavur, the farmers led by association general secretary PR Pandian blocked the Mannargudi-Mayiladuthurai train. They raised slogans demanding the government to ensure 5,000 cusecs of Cauvery water was released for 15 days to TN from Karnataka reservoirs in accordance with Cauvery Water Management Authority directions.

The protesting farmers also said kuruvai paddy was wilting in lakhs of acres and samba cultivation could not be commenced due to unavailability of water in Mettur dam. They criticised the union government for "favour-

ing" Karnataka in the dispute. The police detained 170 farmers in a wedding hall. The train resumed its journey after a delay of around 40 minutes.

Pandian said the union and state governments should come forward to release a compensation of ₹35,000 per acre to the affected farmers.

In Thanjavur, farmers led by

association state president L Paniappan tried to enter the railway junction to stage the protest. While 80 farmers were detained, six of them entered the station and staged a rail roko.

In Mayiladuthurai, the farmers led by association district president R Vaithiyanathan staged the protest in front of Sirkazhi railway station.

"The mother could have abandoned the cubs because of its weak body or possible diseases. But the exact reason can be ascertained only after we get the forensic results. The stomach of all the four cubs was empty. Tiger cubs normally feed on milk for two years," he said. N Sadiq Ali, founder of wildlife and nature conservation trust, said "The state should appoint more field staff to strengthen patrolling in areas frequented by tigers and elephants. Drones and other facilities must be provided to track animals and to protect the staffers from animal attacks. ENS

A member of INDIA bloc, not partner, clarifies CPM

AS the CPM's decision to stay away from the organisational structure of the Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance (INDIA) has invited flak from political circles, the party leadership has dismissed criticism that Kerala CPM's animos-

ity towards the Congress has resulted in the decision to stay away from the coordination committee. "The CPM is a member and part of INDIA, but not a partner," a senior politburo member told TNE.

"CPM is a part of INDIA but we won't be part of its organisational set-up. It is our political

stand that we will not be part of any pre-poll alliance," he said. The CPM sees INDIA as a block of opposition parties formed to keep the BJP away from power at the national level. At the INDIA bloc meetings held in Patna, Bengaluru and Mumbai, CPM made it clear that decisions should be taken collectively by

the all-party leadership. The politburo meeting held on September 16 and 17 had decided to work for further consolidation of INDIA bloc. Successive party congresses declared CPM's primary aim is to oust BJP from power. The politburo decided to initiate political action to further strengthen these efforts.

Orders reserved on Naidu's quash plea

ANDHRA Pradesh high court on Tuesday reserved its orders in the petition filed by former Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu seeking quashing of the case against him in the alleged scam in AP State Skill Development Corporation.

While Naidu's counsel in-

formed the petitioner was victim of 'regime revenge' and including him in the case needs prior sanction as per Section 17A of the Prevention of Corruption Act, the State said it does not need to obtain sanction to investigate Naidu and submitted the act of fabricating records can not be termed as 'official duty.'
