Bengaluru, August 8 Siddaramaiah paid an unannounced visit to Victoria Hospital Bengaluru, emphasizing the need for doctors to treat patients with compassion and patience. Noting the pressures associated with providing free treatment, Siddaramaiah instructed medical staff to maintain empathy in their service and firmly directed them not to accept money from any patients.

Following the cancellation of his Koppal program due to heavy rains, the Chief Minister interacted directly with patients, several of whom praised the care and food provided by the hospital staff. Siddaramaiah highlighted that complex procedures like organ transplants,



which can cost 30-40 lakhs in private hospitals, are conducted free of charge at

Victoria Hospital. Addressing concerns raised by reporters about the prevalence of private ambulance services, Siddaramaiah confirmed that government-operated '108' ambulances are available. He also noted a proposal to expand the gasdepartment from 120 to 300 beds is under active consideration, to better accommodate the high volume of patients. The Chief Minister underscored the government's commitment to filling vacant doctor posts and increasing hospital capacity to serve the growing number of

people seeking treatment. Siddaramaiah further visited Vani Vilas Hospital and the Trauma Center, where more than 40 deliveries take place each day, reflecting the growing patient load and urgent need for expanded facilities. He assured that the government will examine issues such as paid parking within the hospital complex.

Rural Development Minister Priyank Kharge holds discussions with officials to address technical issues and challenges in e-Asset operations

Bengaluru : Priyank Kharge, Rural Development Minister said that The department is in the process of making the Karnataka Gram Swaraj and Panchayat Raj (Taxes, Rates and Fees of Gram Panchayats) Rules, 2025 available to the public.

The Minister also said that these rules will facilitate online issuance of e-khatas for over 97 lakh digitised properties available on the Panchatantra 2.0 platform, thereby eliminating the need for citizens to



visit Gram Panchayat offices for khata services.

In view of the fact that the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department is going to launch the e-Asset program as per the Karnataka Gram Swaraj and Panchayat Raj (Amendment) Act, held discussions with officials to address technical issues and challenges and suggested some remedial measures. The process of converting the e-Asset sanction system from a demand-based approach to a campaign-based model is underway, and the ministers held meetings in this regard. Officials of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) held a long discussion with the data centre of the Rural Development Department and senior officials of the department.

Odisha CM, Union Steel Minister Discuss Expansion of Rourkela Steel Plant and Iron Ore

New Delhi, August 6 Odisha Minister Mohan Charan Majhi called on Union Minister for Heavy Steel and Industries Kumaraswamy in the capital to discuss strategic interventions aimed at advancing Odisha's role as a leading steel-producing state. Central to their talks was the proposed expansion of the Rourkela Steel Plant (RSP), with plans to more than double its production capacity to

approximately 9 million tonnes per annum by 2030 through an estimated 30,000 crore investment.

Minister Kumaraswamy underscored the Rourkela Steel Plant's pivotal role in national steel output, affirming the Centre's full backing under the leader-ship of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Discussions included fasttracking the expansion project, which will involve new raw material handling facilities, a coke oven stamp charge battery, a sinter plant, cold and silicon rolling mills, as well as the addition of a new blast furnace and steel melting shop. The expansion will take place over 1,200 acres on the plant's south-eastern side and will require upgrades to supporting infrastruc-ture, including the doubling of railway lines for logistics and transport efficiency. Ensuring a sustainable sup-

MP Basavaraj Bommai urges Nitin Gadkari to expedite work on Karwar-Ilkal National Highway New Delhi: Former Chief Minister and

MP Basavaraj Bommai has urged Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari to treat the Karwar-Ilkal National Highway, which falls under the Haveri–Gadag Lok Sabha constituency, as a special case and to prepare the Detailed Project Report (DPR) at the earliest and commence work soon.Meeting Union Minister Nitin Gadkari in New Delhi, Bommai submitted that a route of about 318 km—starting from Karwar and passing through Kaiga, Mundgod, Savanur, Gadag, and Gajendragad to reach Ilkal—has already received in-principle approval for upgradation to a National Highway. The DPR for the project has been submitted, and land acquisition has been decided upon. He pointed out that since the road has been earmarked for upgradation to a National Highway, its current condition—owing to poor maintenance by the state government—has become unfit for



vehicular movement. On the other hand, as the project has not yet received formal approval, the National Highways Authority has not been able to undertake any work. Therefore, he requested that this be considered a special case and that the road be immediately upgraded to National Highway status and work be commenced without delay.
