
### On Environment Day, Vizag looks for ways to rid itself of plastic pollution

Private and public institutions, NGOs and educational institutions in the cicelebrated World Environment Day on Monday with focus on solutions to plastic pollution under theme

#BeatPlasticPollution. The Visakhapatnam Regional Office of the Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board (APPCB) organised a 'green rally' in association with the Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation (GVMC). Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) chairman and regional coordinator Y.V. Subba Reddy, who participated as chief guest, flagged off the rally.

# Only three deaths at Ayyagarlapalli due to renal issues: officials

They say fluoride content in water within permissible limits; medical department deputes officer to inquire into seven deaths over three years

he District Medical and Health Department had deputed a Medical Officer to Ayyagarlapalli in Settur mandal of the district to inquire into the seven deaths that occurred there in the past three years, reportedly due to kidney ailments. The move came after a report published in The Hin-

*du* highlighted the issue. A Tehsildar was also deputed by the Kalyandurg Revenue Divisional Officer to inquire into the issue.

A report sent by District Medical and Health Officer K. Veerabbai to the Director of Public Health and Family Welfare said that only three of the said seven people died due to kidney ailments, and one person suffered from a renal cortical cyst, but their Renal Func-

tion Test was normal. The Settur PHC Medical Officer Tharuna Sai's report says that of the seven deaths, three were caused by heart stroke, one died

due to T.B., and the rest of the three had kidney ailments and one was undergoing dialysis treatment. Among these three who

died due to kidney ailments, Ramanna used to take painkillers prescribed by Registered Medical Practitioners for a long time, and Hanumanthappa was an alcoholic for more than 30 years, the report said.

In response to The Hindu report, the officials said that the village Ayyagarlapalli has a population of 2,117. The villagers consumed drinking water from an R.O. water filter plant from Pennahobilam Reservoir and local borewell water supplied by the Panchayat Raj, they said.

The officials said that the fluoride content of the water the villagers drank was 0.5 ppm, which was within the permissible li-

The village has two alcohol shops and eight RMPs, according to the official report.

Now, 18 persons were taking treatment for hypertension, 27 others for diabetes, and one person was getting kidney dialysis, the report added.

### Sri Lanka-bound ganja intercepted in Tirupati, 4 Chennaiites among 8 held

The Tirupati district police nabbed an international ganja smuggling gang and seized 240 kg of ganja bound for Sri Lanka on Monday. The contraband was being transported from Anakapalle when it was intercepted at Sullurpeta on the Kolkata-Chennai national highway, said

Special Enforcement Bureau (SEB) Additional Superintendent N. Rajendra and a team led by Deputy Superintendent M. Rajagopal Reddy had conducted vehicle checks at the Sullurpeta bypass road when they found 120 packets (240 kg) of ganja in a concealed chamber in a truck coming from the Nellore side.

The police immediately intercepted an SUV that piloted the truck and nabbed

those inside it. The arrested included C. Ananda Velu (48), Bala Krishnan (60), C. Tirumala (38), K. Raghunathan (41), all from Chennai and J. Varadarajan (37) of Tindiva-

nam, D. Luv Raju (28), Kakarla Yesu (25) and B. Ravi (41) from Anakapalle. Appala Naidu of Anakapalle and Khader Bhai of Sri Lanka are on the run, said the police.

Producing the seized contraband before the media on Monday, Superintendent of Police P. Parameswara Reddy said that the main accused, Ananda Velu, was a habitual offender operating along Tamil Nadu coastal belt, including Chennai, Rameswaram, Thoothukudi, DhaThe contraband was being transported from Anakapalle when it was intercepted

nushkodi, Velanganni, Nagapatnam and Tiruchendur to ensure regular ganja supply to Sri Lanka. "He made transactions in gold instead of cash," Mr. Reddy explained.

Ananda Velu w ed in several cases across Andhra Pradesh, including a redsanders smuggling case of 2005 in Tirupati.

The other accused, Appala Naidu, has a Preventive Detention Act case registered against him, charging him of smuggling ganja from the Odisha border to his counterparts in Tamil Nadu.

"We have initiated the process of serving red corner notice and lookout notice through the CID to nab Khader Bhai," the Superintendent said. He presented rewards to the excelling police personnel of Sullurpeta and Doravari Satram stations for busting the
