Keep your word, withdraw farm laws: Farmers

KRRS accuses former BJP govt of playing into corporates' hands and acting against farmers' welfare

HUNDREDS of farmers belonging to the Karnataka Rajya Raitha Sangha (KRRS) held a protest in Mysuru on Thursday demanding that Chief Minister Siddaramaiah-led government withdraw three controversial farm laws and programmes implemented by the previous BJP government.

The farmers, led by KRRS state president Badagalapura Nagendra, gathered near the deputy commissioner's office and shouted slogans against the BJP and the RSS, accusing the saffron party of introducing policies which are against the welfare of the farmers. KRRS activists, as part of the 'Raithagraha Dharani', simultaneously held protests in 28 districts of the state.

Speaking to reporters, Nagendra said the BJP govern-

ment had introduced the Land Reforms Amendment Act 2020, Karnataka Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation and Development) Amendment Act 2020 and the Karnataka

Prevention of Slaughter and Preservation of Cattle Act 2020 which are against the interest of the farmers.

"The BJP government introduced a land reforms legisla-

tion to support corporate companies. By introducing anti-cow slaughter law, the then government has caused irreparable damage to dairy farming. Farmers, Dalits, labourers, women and students are protesting against the three laws since 2020. The Congress which had expressed its support to farmers' agitation had announced in its mani-

festo that it will withdraw the laws if it came to power. So, we urge the Congress government to immediately withdraw the three laws and introduce pro-farmers laws and initiatives in the state," he said.

Recalling that the Siddaramaiah government in 2013 had set up the Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices, Nagendra said the government must give autonomous status and appoint a pro-farmer chairperson to the commission to introduce the MS Swaminathan Committee report to fix a minimum support price for farmers' produce.

"The government must create a revival fund and earmark Rs 5,000 crore to procure the farmers produce and prevent the linking of Aadhaar number to agri-

culture-related electricity meters and provide free electricity for 10 HP agricultural pumpsets. The government must also ensure Rs 20,000 minimum price for copra per quintal and provide sufficient seeds, fertilisers and pes-

ticides for cultivation," he said. The farmers later submitted a memorandum to the state government through the dis-

trict administration.

New species of weed worries M'dya ryots

MANDYA farmers who are already in distress due to insufficient water for their crops are now facing another problem. The agriculture fields are getting infested with an unknown weed species.

The new weed species has started to engulf the entire agriculture land when the farmers are preparing themselves for the monsoon crop. While the farmers are preparing to sow sugarcane, paddy, ragi and millets, the new weed species has left them worried.

While weed species like Konnare, Garike or Bermuda Grass, Karigatti Hullu and this problem," he said. Mysuru Honagone or Parthenium are found in sugarcane fields, Gandu Batha, Odakebeeja and Jondu weeds are found in paddy fields. These weeds reduce the crop yield as they use the nutrients provided to the crops. The sugarcane and paddy farmers had to till land for three months to remove the weeds which, if left unattended, will prevent growth of the sugarcane.

The farmers are now worried that the new species of weed which looks like a mixture of

parthenium and Mysuru Honagone has gradually spread in the land.

Progressive farmer U C Shekar from Ummadahalli village said the new species of weed is spreading to agriculture lands in several parts of Mandya.

"The new species of weed is spreading fast. I am worried that using pesticide to kill the weed will destroy the fertility of the soil. This weed is found in Ragimuddhanahalli, Thubinakere, Kodishettipura, Hosakoppalu and surrounding areas in Mandya taluk. We want agriculture department officials and scientists to visit the fields and find solutions to

Another farmer Basavaraju from Ragimuddhanahalli village said he is seeing the weed for the first time in the agriculture field. "It has spread to a large area in my field. Removing the weed has become a huge task for us," he said.

Meanwhile, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, VC Farm agriculture scientist Mahesh said they will visit the fields to know the weed species. "After the investigation, we can come to know the weed and solution to prevent it," he said.

According to the complaint filed by Hemalatha (45), a resident of Bengaluru and a techie, she had been cheated by K B Mahesh of Mysuru. The victim stated that she had uploaded her profile on a marriage portal. Mahesh, claiming himself as an orthopedic surgeon, contacted her. After the consent from her parents, she married Mahesh in January. Within a few days, Mahesh asked her to apply for a loan of `70 lakh to open a clinic. When she refused, Mahesh, in the first week of February, fled with 200 grams of gold and `15 lakh belonging to her.
