



Nitish Kumar Reddy trains players ahead of APL season

INDIA cricketer Nitish Kumar Reddy participated in practice sessions with an Andhra Premier League (APL) team ahead of the tournament, which is scheduled to be held from June 9 to June 30 across Visakhapatnam, Kadapa and Mangalagiri.

In a statement, the Andhra Cricket Association (ACA) said Nitish's presence during training sessions provided valuable guidance and encouragement to fellow players.

However, he will not be available for APL matches as he will be on national duty with the Indian team during the tournament period.

The ACA thanked Nitish for supporting the league and interacting with players during the preparatory phase.

Officials stated his involvement had generated interest in the tournament and served as motivation for young cricketers in the State.

The Andhra Premier League will feature seven teams including Bhimavaram Bulls, Royals of Rayalaseema, Vijayawada Sunshiners, Amaravathi Royals, Simhadri Lions, Kakina Kings and Tungabhadra Warriors.

The APL competition will be played in a round-robin format across the three venues from June 9 to 30.

THE Andhra Pradesh Government has strongly refuted the baseless, politically motivated and misleading allegations being propagated regarding Mega DSC-2025.

Addressing the media on Saturday, Education Secretary Kona Sasidhar categorically stated that every stage of the Mega DSC recruitment process was conducted transparently, fairly and strictly in accordance with notified rules, government orders and legal provisions.

He said the allegations being circulated through certain newspapers, YouTube channels and social media platforms have no factual basis and are aimed solely at creating confusion among youth and tarnishing one of the most successful recruitment drives in the state's history.

Sasidhar said Mega DSC-2025 was conducted nearly seven years after the previous DSC

held in 2018. A total of 16,347 teacher posts were notified, and around 3.36 lakh candidates applied for the recruitment process.

Sasidhar stated that Mega DSC-2025 was conducted strictly in accordance with reservation rosters, notified recruitment rules and government orders. Despite numerous legal challenges, no court granted a stay against the examination process. There is no judicial finding anywhere that the Mega DSC process violated court orders or recruitment norms.

Despite facing 226 legal challenges during the course of recruitment and a total of 241 court cases overall, including one before the Supreme Court, the government successfully defended the process and completed the recruitment exercise in a record 145-148 days without any judicial interruption.

He noted that 15,941 appointment orders were ultimately issued to deserving candidates



after completion of all stages of examination, verification and selection.

Rejecting allegations of question paper leakage, the education secretary clarified that Mega DSC examinations were conducted through TCS iON, one of India's most trusted Computer-Based Testing platforms used by SSC, RRB, IBPS, NTA, IITs, AIIMS, APPSC, APSCE and the Andhra Pradesh High Court.

Different question papers were generated for different examination sessions through a randomised question bank system comprising nearly 42,000 questions prepared under strict

confidentiality by subject experts.

Dismissing claims that merit lists were never published, he explained that the recruitment process followed a transparent and publicly disclosed schedule.

The merit lists contained candidate IDs, names, scores, ranks, community categories and local/non-local status. Multiple SMS alerts were sent to candidates regarding publication of scores and merit rankings.

Certificate verification commenced only after publication of merit lists.

Therefore, allegations that candidates were informed solely through private messages or that merit lists were hidden are completely false.

The government rejected allegations regarding reservation violations and stated that Mega DSC-2025 was among the most socially inclusive recruitment exercises ever conducted in Andhra Pradesh.

'DSC Recruitment under sports quota transparent'

THE Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh (SAAP) has clarified that the recruitment process of DSC 2025 conducted under the sports quota was carried out in a completely transparent, rule-based, and multi-level verification system.

The clarification was issued in response to false and baseless reports published by certain sections of the media regarding the recruitment process.

According to SAAP, the entire recruitment process was conducted online and based solely on verified documents. Sports certificates submitted by candidates were not issued, created, or authenticated by

SAAP. These certificates are issued only by the respective sports associations, federations, and universities.

SAAP stated that every certificate submitted by applicants was sent to the concerned issuing authority for official verification of its authenticity.

Certificates were considered for eligibility and merit assessment only after receiving confirmation from the issuing organisations. No certificate without verification was taken into account during the selection process.

SAAP further said that a notification was issued on May 1, 2025, for filling 421 Mega DSC posts under the sports quota. Around 3,600 candidates applied online, submitting a total of 5,328 post preferences.

5 drown in Tungabhadra

IN a tragic incident five persons were drowned in Tungabhadra River near Mantralayam of Kurnool district on Saturday. They were swept away by strong currents in the Tungabhadra River while taking a leisure swim, said Mantralayam Circle Inspector Dastagiri.

According to police, the victims were identified as Satish (35) and Yuvan Chandra (5) from Hyderabad, Raghavendra (25) and Dhanu (23) from Mantralayam, and Sandhya

(22) from Uravakonda. Aparna of Adoni survived the incident. Preliminary investigation revealed that around ten members of a family and relatives went to Mantralayam to attend a family function and perform Satyanarayana Puja.

Later, six members ventured into the river for swimming. They reportedly misjudged the water depth and were caught in strong currents. After relatives on the riverbank raised an alarm, police rushed to the spot and launched a rescue operation.

Union Minister Giriraj inaugurates medical textiles testing lab at AMTZ

UNION Minister for Textiles Giriraj Singh on Saturday inaugurated a Medical Textiles Testing Laboratory at the Andhra Pradesh MedTech Zone (AMTZ) in Visakhapatnam and reviewed several manufacturing and research facilities within the campus.

The Minister was received by Dr Jitendra Sharma, Managing Director and Founder CEO of AMTZ, who briefed him on the



facility's role in supporting the medical technology and technical textiles sectors.

During the visit, the Minister inaugurated the Medical Textiles Testing Laboratory, which is designed to test and validate healthcare and technical tex-

tile products such as surgical gowns, masks, personal protective equipment (PPE), drapes and wound-care materials. Officials explained that the laboratory is equipped to assess barrier efficiency, microbial resistance and safety performance, providing quality assurance support for medical textile manufacturers.

The Minister also visited the IMEDS facility, where surgical skin staplers and sterile wound-closure consumables are being manufactured.
